WELCOME AND INTRODUCTION

The Convention was called to order at 11:10 a.m.

REORGANIZING CONVENTION

Report from Steering Committee on 2011-2012.

Election of Steering Committee Members. Three members were nominated for the Steering Committee, and both were elected. All were elected to two-year terms (2012-2014): Sue Edward, Scott West, and Joseph Martin. Two seats were left vacant.

NOMINATING CONVENTION

Nomination of Candidates. Other candidates were then proposed and discussed. By consensus, the following candidates received a nomination from the Green Party:

Presidential Preferences. The four presidential candidates were discussed. The results of the preference vote: 6 for Jill Stein, 2 for Roseanne Barr.

Election of Delegates to the National Convention. South Carolina has been allocated 8 delegates to the national convention. The following people were elected: Scott West, Gregg Jocoy, Sue Edward, Larry Carter Center, Bill Kreml, Jeanne van den Hurk, Sara Williams, and Joseph Martin. Leslie Miner was elected as an alternate.
